Dear Parents and Carers,

In order to consolidate our science learning, we are intending to visit **Jodrell Bank Discovery Centre** in South Cheshire on **Wednesday 6th February 2019**. Jodrell Bank is the largest space telescope in the United Kingdom. The children will have the opportunity to take part in experiments within the exhibition as well as understand how images of outer space can be captured.

Children will need to arrive at school at **8:30am** via the front entrance, where they will be registered and supervised in the hall. The coach will be leaving promptly at 8:45am. We will travel to Jodrell Bank and arrive at around 10:30am. We will be leaving Jodrell Bank at 2:30pm hoping to return to school by **5:00pm**. We will update you on our expected time of arrival via the Parent Mail system.

A voluntary contribution of **£20.00** is requested to cover the cost of the visit. Whilst there is no obligation on the part of parents to contribute to the cost of activities in school time, and pupils will not be treated differently according to whether or not their parents make a contribution, the visit will unfortunately not go ahead if we do not receive adequate financial support. Please let Miss Buffery know, in confidence, if this causes difficulty or if you would prefer to pay in instalments, especially if you have more than one child in school. We are aware that this is an expensive visit. With this in mind, we have organised our final visit of the year alongside this one. The cost of our summer term visit to The Thinktank, Birmingham will not exceed £11.00.

Children will be required to dress in full school uniform, with sensible shoes and a warm coat. Children will be responsible for looking after their belongings on the day, the only things that the children need to bring are; a packed lunch, drink and a healthy snack (no fizzy drinks or products containing nuts please) in a suitable bag that will be comfortable for your child to carry. If you would like your child to have a packed lunch from school, please fill out the consent form below and send in **£2.65**.

As there is a gift shop at Jodrell Bank, children are welcome to bring £5.00 spending money, in a sealed wallet or purse. Please do not allow children to bring any more than £5.00, as we will only have a limited amount of time in the shop.

I'm sure you will agree that this is an amazing opportunity to engage your child in practical learning. Please complete the attached consent form and return to the school office along with payment by **Tuesday 29th January 2019**. If there are any further questions, please do not hesitate to ask.
