Dear Parents/Carers,

As reading is a high priority on our school improvement plan and an essential life skill, we are excited to launch 'Recycled Reads' which is an initiative to recycle much loved books and to increase our pupil's reading opportunities.

As Christmas is nearly upon us and Father Christmas may bring new books into your household we are aware that sometimes our families have a sort out after Christmas and give their old books away to other children or charity shops. Reading books are really important to us at Manor Way and we are always trying to find ways to increase the number of books and replace the books that have reached the end of their life.

We have compiled a suggested book list, for each class library of books that are great reads and age appropriate. If you have any of these books that you are looking to recycle then we would kindly ask you to donate them to our class book corners. The suggested book list shows some of the texts we would like to add to the childrens' class libraries. You can donate to any of the classes and you may also have a book that is not on the list which would be gratefully received.

Every book that is donated to school will be given a special book plate sticker, which will have the name of the child who has donated the book and their year group, stuck into the front of the book. We think this is a lovely idea and will enable the book to be read many times over whilst acknowledging the kindness of the child that donated the book.

The book lists for the classes are attached to this letter and we will also put them on the website. Please check that the books are in good condition and all the pages are in the book. Please hand any 'recycled reads' into the office with a piece of paper sharing which child has donated the book.

We hope that you will support us in this initiative which will give old books a new home and enable our children to have greater choice in their class libraries.


